# Faith in the North East – social action by Faith communities in the region

## Projects & Services Directory

The CRC has compiled this directory of projects and services for the area covered by North East Churches. The Directory is based on data collected for the Faith in the North East Survey conducted by the CRC with the assistance of Dr Kath Smith, Durham University, in 2004. It is intended to serve as a reference and signpost to the projects and facilities provided by Faith groups for their local communities in each local authority area. We hope that the Directory will encourage networking, provide information for potential users and serve as an initial signpost for public authorities and agencies.

From the 1448 Faith communities surveyed in 2004, 743 responses were received. This has since risen to 868. What the Directory clearly reveals is the significant contribution to social capital made by Faith communities through their engagement in project activity.

It is certain, however, that many projects will have been missed and we hope that this Directory will help to identify gaps in information. If you spot any glaring omissions, or if you notice that a featured project no longer exists, then Stuart Allan at CRC would be glad to hear from you.
